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In the current year from 1st April 2019 the company has changed the method of valuation of finished goods and work in progress from batch costing method to weighted average cost method. Thus the own-manufactured stock for the period ended 30th September 2019 is stated at weighted average cost, whereas the corresponding stock for the previous year is valued as per batch costing method.
